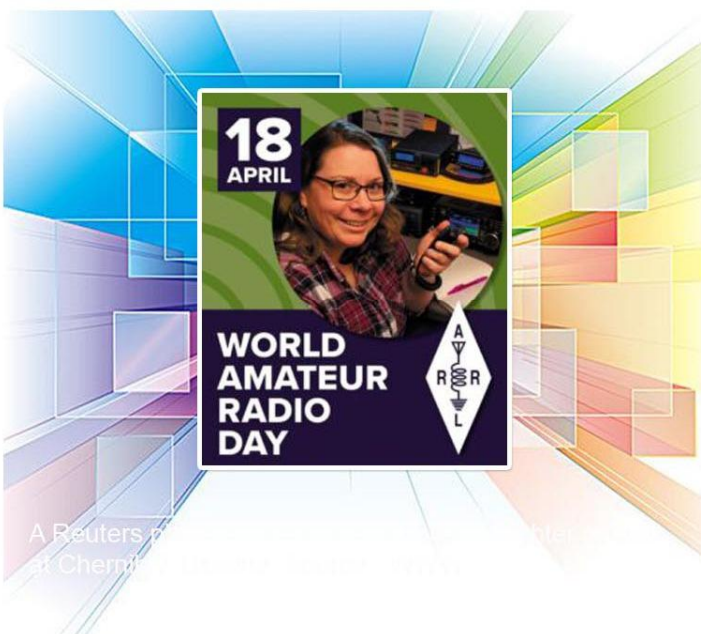


The World Amateur Radio Day

World Amateur Radio Day is celebrated every year on April 18. Radio amateurs or HAM radio operators worldwide take to the airwaves in celebration of this special day.



It was on this day in 1925 that the International Amateur Radio Union (IARU) was formed in Paris, France. Since then, the IARU has tirelessly worked to broaden the range of bandwidth available to radio amateurs and has expanded its organisation to include members from 25 countries all over the world at the last count. Interest in amateur radio has only grown since those early days, with over 30,00,000 licensed operators making their voices heard across the globe today. It's through this medium that people from different nations and cultures were able to spread ideas with great speed, long before an email or video chat came into being. Today IARU is a federation of more than 160 national amateur radio organisations in as many countries and separate territories. The International Secretariat of the IARU is at ARRL - The National Association for Amateur Radio in the United States.

The theme for the World Amateur Radio Day 2022 as chosen by the IARU administrative council was "Celebrating Amateur Radio's contribution to society".

Yes, the theme was rightly chosen. Amateur radio plays a very important role for the society. We can vividly remember that when the outbreak of COVID-19 first pushed much of the world into lockdown, one traditional - some might even say old-fashioned hobby, experienced a spectacular revival. Amateur radio lets people interact socially, intensively without ever meeting in person. In those early days of the pandemic, radio

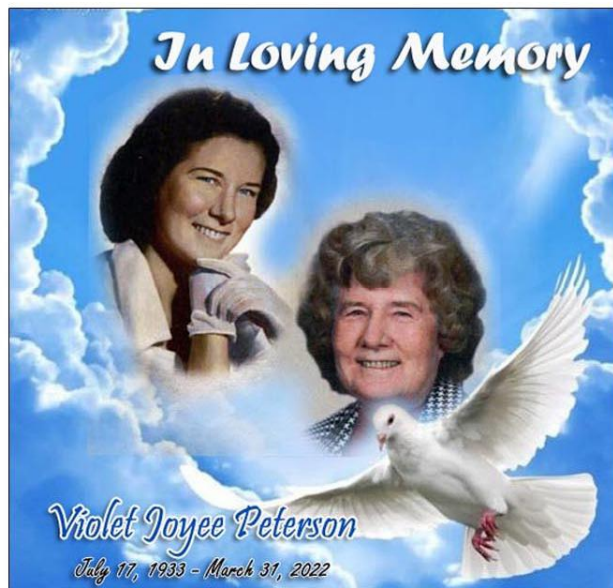

My Tribute: “She is My Girl”

It is with a heavy heart that I announce the death of my dear wife, Violet, at the age of 88. She breathed her last with me in the home of our daughter and her husband in Martinsville Indiana in the United States soon after early daylight on Thursday March 31, 2022.

My wife was born as the seventh child in the prominent Adventist Double family in suburban Sydney Australia on Monday July 17, 1933. She was indeed named after the pretty flower, the Australian version of the English Violet, and the color violet was also her own favorite color. The name violet symbolizes truth and loyalty, while it also embodies a sense of modesty, spiritual wisdom and humility.

All seven of the Double siblings gained their education in various educational units operated by the Adventist church in the state of New South Wales, Australia, and they all entered service with the church in Australia, New Zealand, New Guinea and the Pacific Islands. In their varied capabilities they served in medical mission work, educational institutions, as church pastors, and as secretaries. An older sister married a pastor who served as President in four consecutive territories, in Australia and New Zealand.

Allow me to reminisce a little. Way back when I was a student at Avondale College (University) in a country area between the major cities of Sydney and Newcastle, I happened to observe a small group of girls who were part of the intake of new students for the new school year. One of those girls wore a dress in blue that was made up of one complete flower pattern. I thought to myself: That girl has a touch of class.

During the following year, we began a new friendship, and we exchanged large photographic portraits. The colorized photo of the pretty 18-year-old Violet stood in a frame on my study desk in the Boy's Dormitory at Avondale. That photo declared unequivocally: She is my girl!

After college, and after marriage, we served in pastoral and radio ministry in three states of Australia (South Australia, Tasmania, Western Australia) and then volunteered for overseas service that took us to British India for nearly 20 years.

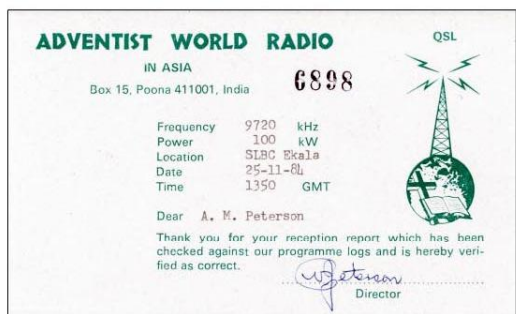
It was in Colombo Sri Lanka that I was invited to launch a new DX program for broadcast in the international shortwave service of SLBC, the Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation. A quick transfer then took us to Poona (Pune) in India where we served for 10 years at the production studios of what became the original AWR-Asia, Adventist World Radio in Asia, the largest of more than 100 AWR radio studios on all continents.

After the death of Prime Minister Indira Gandhi, the political scene in India changed, and it became necessary for 3,000 missionary families of all Christian denominations to leave India. The AWR headquarters on the edge of Washington DC invited us to take up residency in the United States and to retain our service with Adventist World Radio. For us it was: From India to Indiana. It was here in Indianapolis Indiana that Violet took employment as a secretary for various commercial medical units, though she often assisted with various activities and events associated with the AWR office in Indianapolis.

Violet Joyce (Double) Peterson lived a full and productive life. She loved her family (son Melvyn in aviation in Asia and daughter Janelle in education in Indiana), she loved her church, where she served as organist, and she loved her God. She served her grateful husband lovingly and completely, and she was appreciated and honored by those whom she befriended.

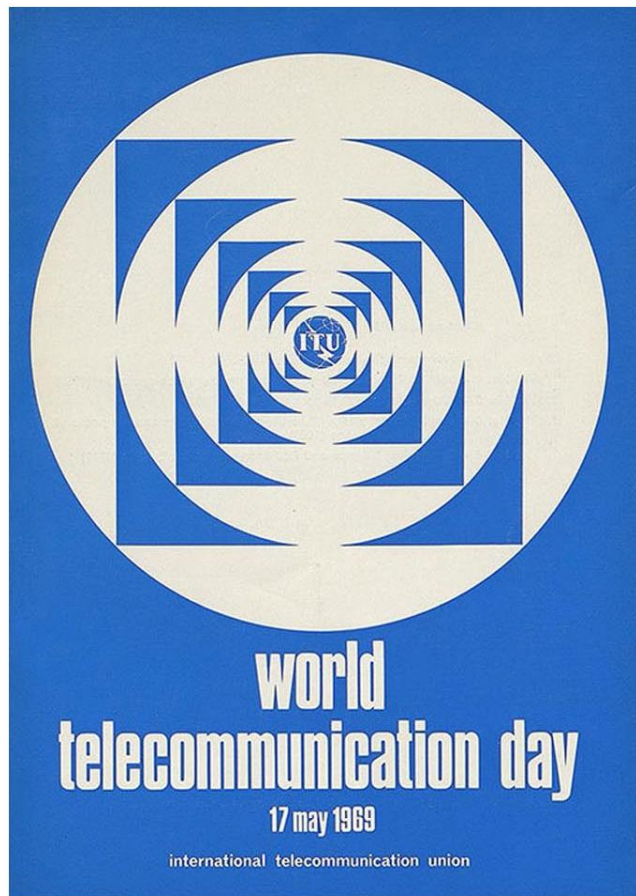
World Telecommunication & Information

Society Day, 17 May 2022

Theme: "Digital technologies for older persons and healthy ageing"

The purpose of World Telecommunication and Information Society Day (WTISD) is to help raise awareness of the possibilities that the use of the Internet and other information and communication technologies (ICT) can bring to societies and economies, as well as of ways to bridge the digital divide.

17 May marks the anniversary of the signing of the first International Telegraph Convention and the creation of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).



History

World Information Society Day

World Telecommunication Day has been celebrated annually on 17 May since 1969, marking the founding of ITU and the signing of the first International Telegraph Convention in 1865. It was instituted by the Plenipotentiary Conference in Malaga-Torremolinos in 1973 as Resolution 46.

World Telecommunication Day

In November 2005, the World Summit on the Information Society called upon the UN General Assembly to declare 17 May as World Information Society Day to focus on the importance of ICT and the wide range of issues related to the Information Society raised by WSIS. The General Assembly adopted a resolution (A/RES/60/252) in March 2006 stipulating that World Information Society Day shall be celebrated every year on 17 May.

World Telecommunication and Information Society Day

In November 2006, the ITU Plenipotentiary Conference in Antalya, Turkey, decided to celebrate both events on 17 May as World Telecommunication and Information Society Day. The updated Resolution 68 invites Member States and Sector Members to celebrate the day annually by organizing appropriate national programmes with a view to:

- stimulating reflection and exchanges of ideas on the theme adopted by the Council
- debating the various aspects of the theme with all partners in society
- formulating a report reflecting national discussions on the issues underlying the theme, to be fed back to ITU and the rest of its membership

GRIGORIOPOL EXPLOSIONS

Grigoriopol is a town founded by Armenians in 1792 in what is now Transnistria, which is a state internationally recognized as part of Moldova. It is located on the left bank of the river Dniester. The Grigoriopol (Russian designation: Mayak Radio Centre) is a very large broadcasting facility situated near Maïac, an urban settlement 11 km northeast of Grigoriopol, Transnistria.

Construction work on this facility known as the Pridnestrovian radio and television center with an area of estimated 950 hectares, which housed at the beginning of the 1990s over 20 transmitters working in the shortwave and mediumwave frequencies, took place between 1968 and 1975. The antennae consisted of several antennae for shortwave with heights between 60 and 160 metres and a large rotatable shortwave antenna, which could focus its radiation to every point on the Earth! After the collapse of the Soviet Union, these transmitters were used by several foreign broadcasting companies. In 1997 several antennae were destroyed or damaged by excessive icing. The largest loss was a 350 metres tall guyed mast and a 250 metres tall mast used for mediumwave service.



On Monday, the 25th April, 2022, authorities said the offices of the state security ministry in Tiraspol were hit by what appeared to be a grenade attack. Next day i.e., on Tuesday, the 26th April, 2022 early morning, two blasts occurred, first at 6:40 am and then at 7:05 am (0340 UTC and 0405 UTC) targeting the “Mayak” radio center, about 50 kilometers (30 miles) from the regional capital Tiraspol. Reports said that as of 9 am, the two most powerful antennae are out of service, one a 1000 kW and the other a 500 kW. Thankfully none of the PRTC (Pridnestrovian radio and television center) employees and local residents was injured. This is one of 14 radio transmitting centers of the former USSR. The signal from the PRTC can be relayed to the USA, the Middle East and Latin America.

The Government said two “powerful” antennae that were re-broadcasting Russian radio were out of service, and shared images of them lying on the ground. There was no immediate reason to suggest a link between the two incidents.

As of 2021, the facility was being used as a medium wave transmitter for Vesti FM on 1413 kHz with 500 kW

and Trans World Radio on 999 kHz (500 kW) and 1548 kHz (1000 kW), The shortwave transmissions were on 9940, 11805, 11530 and 11570 kHz mostly for TWR.

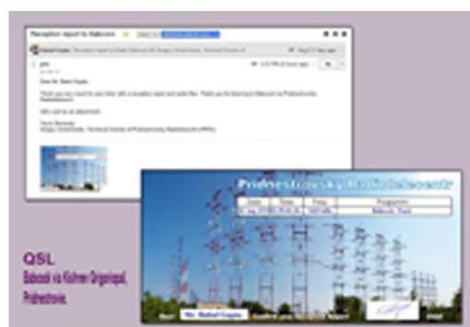
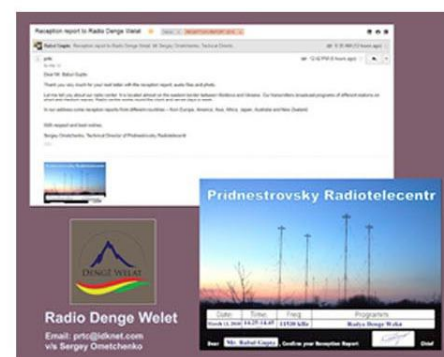
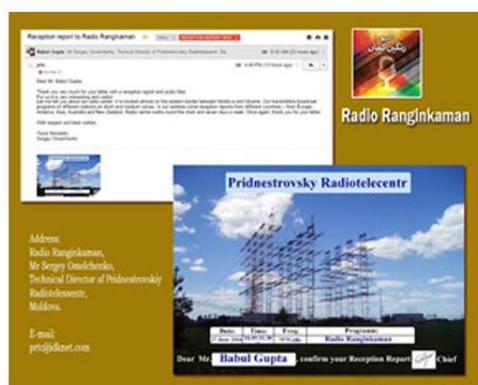


Transnistria: Drone captures two cell towers toppled due to alleged explosions

An official from the transmitter site confirmed that shortwave antennae were destroyed. There were no shortwave broadcasts from this site, the last one was Dengê Welat, which Ivo Ivanov, the DXer, reported that it stopped on 18th April, 2022. However, both MW frequencies 1413 kHz and 999 kHz were back on air at around 1630 UTC which confirms that only shortwave antennas were affected.

The TWR, user of the transmitter site, could not be contacted.
